< On-Campus Residence of Vacation Programs During Winter Vacation >

During 2024 Winter, room painting, window screen replacement and balcony repairs are scheduled at I-House A/B buildings therefore making I-House A/B unavailable for use. Hence, winter programs that were previously held at I-House will be located to E-House and Hanwoori Hall for this winter. We ask for your kind understanding and cooperation.

1) Winter Programs

- * E-House: Around 20 male students from International Winter College (hosted by the Office of International Affairs) to be assigned to building 201(Residential period: 2024.12.24(Tue) ~ 2025.1.10(Fri))
- * Hanwoori Hall: Around 80 female students from International Winter College (hosted by the Office of International Affairs), Short-term Korean Courses (Ewha Language Center), Winter Course for Non-Ewha students

2) Notes

- * The majority of vacation program participants will be non-Ewha participants
- * E-House is scheduled to accommodate around 20 male students
- * Hanwoori Hall is open exclusively for female participants
- * After the winter programs, a comprehensive inspection for any hidden cameras in the rooms used during the program will be conducted
- * Detailed schedules and participant information are to be announced

< E-House Heating Pipe Repair Notice>

During 2024 Winter break, heating pipe inspections and repairs are scheduled for the E-House buildings below. The inspections and repairs are to be conducted to prevent any leaks within the dormitory so we kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation.

- O Date: January 2nd (Thur), 2025 February 14th (Fri), 2025
- O Location: E-House common areas and rooms (Excluding areas undergoing inspection and repairs during the summer vacation and the fifth floor of each building)
- O Scope of Work: Inspection of heating pipes by drilling into inspection holes in the living room ceiling of each unit and performing repairs if necessary
- O Notes:
 - Male workers accompanied by residential assistants will visit units
 - Each unit will take approximately 3-5 days to complete, and there will be noise and dust



- * Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the accommodation options they selected during the dormitory application process. Please carefully review this notice to ensure you are reading the instructions that apply to your resident type.
- 1-YEAR-Resident: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year (including 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the dormitory application
- SEMESTER Resident: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 2nd semester during the dormitory application
- VACATION Resident: A resident who has newly applied for only the winter vacation accommodation and has been assigned a room

(If a current resident applies for and is assigned a winter vacation accommodation, they will be considered a VACATION Resident during the winter vacation period)

- * After the official check-in date, you can check-in during weekdays from 10:00 to 17:00 (Check-in location: Housing Office of each dormitory building)
- * You cannot check-in during weekdays nights(after 17:00), weekends and holidays
- * 1-Year Residents are NOT subjected to document submission or check-in/check-out procedures

II. Check-in Process

- * Please make sure to check your final room/bed number on EUREKA. If you put your belongings in the wrong room, you will get demerit points
- 1) 1-Year-Resident: No check-in process necessary
- 2) VACATION Resident Who Fall Into Either of the Two:
- A. Those who are re-entering the dormitory after residing for 24-Fall and being newly selected as a resident only living in 24-Winter



B. Those who are newly entering the dormitory after being confirmed as a resident only living in 24-Winter

Visit the check-in venue of the dormitory you have been assigned

- → Submit all the required documents and have them checked
- \rightarrow Receive your unit / room password and entrance card \rightarrow Check-in

(Notes: If you were a 24-Fall resident and re-entering, you do not have to submit the required documents)

3) GKS and EGPP graduate students residing in -House

- Due to room painting, window screen replacement and balcony repairs in I-House buildings A/B, please complete the move-in procedures as below.
- Information on your room number at E-House will be provided in December

III. Required Documents upon Check-in

- * Erase the last 6 digits of your Registration Card number when submitting documents
- * In case any document is missing or insufficient, students will be denied to move in to the dormitory

1) Tuberculosis test (Chest X-ray) certificate (Korean or English) issued from 2024. 11. 1(Fri)

- A. Submit an original copy of tuberculosis test (chest x-ray) certificate(Korean and English certificates only)
- B. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) certificate should show the negative results
- C. Students who lived the dormitory during 24-Fall are excluded from submission



IV. Important Information

- 1. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
- 2. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
- 3. During 24-Winter, non-Ewha vacation on-campus program participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). Especially, male participants can be included in the winter programs at E-House and I-House
- 4. There can be various difficulties and inconvenience since the dormitory is a communal space (e.g. noise, communication problems among room/unit mates and etc.)
- 5. There can be noises and entry of workers to the building due to construction and repair work during 24-Winter
 -I-House building A/B: room painting, window screen replacement and balcony repairs are scheduled
 -E-House: heating pipe inspections and repairs are scheduled
- 6. If you cancel your residency or leave the dormitory during the semester, all of your subsequent dormitory applications will be automatically canceled. If you plan to apply for residency again, you can apply from the next semester (those who cancel their residency or leave the dormitory midway cannot re-apply in the same semester)
- 7. In order to protect wallpaper from damage, driving nails to the wall, hanging posters, or any type of wall-hanging items are prohibited. (The housing office may charge any costs associated with recovering the damage caused by such actions to the resident.)
- 8. E-House Bldg. 201~204 B1 walkway is for dormitory residents only. If an outsider is found on the walkway, they will be immediately stopped by the dormitory staff as well as the accompanied resident may be charged with demerit points
 - * Those who fail to comply with the above rules (No. 7, 8) will be given demerit points
- 9. Curfew hours: 00:00~05:00AM for undergraduates only (except for I-House residents)
- 10. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed) (Dorm room pictures: http://my.ewha.ac.kr/dorm/ → Facilities → Rooms)

8. Parcel Room for Mail & Packages

- 2. The Housing Office advises 24-Winter residents to send their packages on or after December 23th in order to not get their packages mixed up with the already existing packages of 24-Fall residents
 - E-House Bldg. 202(B2F) SSG Hall, Hanwoori Bldg. 101 Weight Room, I-House Bldg. A/B B2
- 3. The Housing Office does not keep your package and takes no responsibility for any missing ones
- 4. To the extent that the space permits, small packages will be placed in the mailbox located in the parcel room (storage fee included)
 - * Parcel Room Location: E-House Bldg. 203, 204(B2F), Hanwoori Bldg. 101(1F), I-House Bldg. A/B(B2F)
- 5. Carts may be borrowed for up to 30 minutes from the lobby of Hanwoori Bldg. 101 / B2F lobby of E-House Bldg. 202 / B2F Security office of I-House Bldg. A/B.
- 6. Do not load personal items in the parcel room. They will be thrown away without any prior notice
- 7. Any mail and packages left in the parcel room for a long period of time will be thrown away and you will get demerit points. Special cautions are required for the delivery of food and any perishable items

9. Restriction on Visitors and Entry of Vehicle & Parking

1. Visitors NOT ALLOWED to enter the dorm buildings

During the entire check-in period including official check-in day, only resident students are permitted to enter the residence hall. If an outsider (including your parents) is accompanied/visited into the dorm, you may be charged with demerit points

- 2. Vehicle control in dorm
 - 1) Vehicles are not allowed to park in front of the dormitory (can only stop temporary for unloading). Please use the ECC underground parking lot near the back gate for long-term parking
 - * As the parking space is limited, it is requested to leave immediately after unloading your luggage
 - 2) During the check-in period, access to the dormitory may be blocked for a long time due to other check-in vehicles. Thus the Housing Office recommends students to send their luggage beforehand through parcel services, and bring only light luggage or carriers
 - 3) Parking pass to be given per person
