Facility Construction Notice

During the 26-Summer Vacation period, facility maintenance work will be conducted in several dormitory buildings. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation to ensure that the construction proceeds smoothly and safely for the improvement of dormitory living conditions.

1. E-House Air Conditioner Replacement Work

- Period: 2026. June ~ August
- Building: E-House (Building 203)
- Details: Replacement of air conditioners in all rooms and common areas
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

2. E-House & Hanwoori Wi-Fi Replacement Work

- Period: 2026. June ~ August
- Building: E-House (all buildings) & Hanwoori Building 103 (Ottogi International House)
- Details: Installation of wireless access points (APs) and related cabling
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

※ Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the residence options they selected during the dormitory application process. - **1-YEAR-Resident:** A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year of 2026 (1st semester, summer vacation, 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the 2026 dormitory application
- **SEMESTER-Resident:** A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 1st and 2nd semesters during the 2026 dormitory application
- **VACATION-Resident:** A resident who has newly applied for a summer vacation-only residence and has been assigned a room
 (If a current resident applies for and is assigned a summer vacation-only residence, they will be considered a VACATION-Resident during the summer vacation period)

[1-YEAR-Resident: Residents who applied for 26-Summer dormitory]

1. No application procedure via EUREKA is required as your residence has been confirmed during the initial dormitory application for 2026
2. For residents who have completed payment for 26-Summer, the 26-Spring check-out and 26-Summer check-in procedures are not required, and they will continue to stay in their current rooms
3. **If the 26-Summer dormitory fee is not paid, the entire remaining residence period (summer vacation, 2nd semester, and winter vacation) will be automatically canceled**

[SEMESTER-Resident: Residents who did not apply for 26-Summer dormitory]

1. SEMESTER-Residents who wish to stay in the dormitory during the 26-Summer should apply as VACATION-Residents during the application period for the 26-Summer vacation-only residence. Those SEMESTER-Residents who are assigned as VACATION-Residents must check out from their current rooms by the official 26-Spring check-out date (2026. 6. 23.(Tue) by 14:00) and check in to their newly assigned rooms on the 26-Summer vacation-only residence check-in day (2026. 6. 29.(Mon)).

4. Important Information

▣ Room Assignment and Residence

1. Students will generally be assigned to the same building and room they currently occupy for the Spring semester. However, if unavoidable circumstances arise, the Dormitory Office may assign them to a different building or room for the Summer period (if there are any changes, a separate notice will be provided)
2. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
3. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.)

4. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
5. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
6. **During the Vacation period, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). In particular, I-House may accommodate male participants**

■ Check-in and Check-out

1. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed)

2. **If you cancel your residency or leave the dormitory during the semester, all of your subsequent dormitory applications will be automatically canceled. If you plan to apply for residency again, you can apply from the next semester (those who cancel their residency or leave the dormitory midway cannot re-apply in the same semester)**
3. If an applicant takes leave of absence, is dismissed, takes credits below the standard stated in the eligibility, or does not return from leave of absence, the Dormitory Office may revoke your dormitory application and you cannot re-apply for dormitory. Also, you have a duty to notify the Dormitory Office of any changes in your status. Otherwise, you will be evicted and not allowed to re-apply

■ Facility Maintenance and Construction

1. There can be noises and entry of workers to the building due to construction and repair work during Vacation period
* E-House: Building 203 Air Conditioner Replacement Work
* E-House (all buildings) & Hanwoori Building 103 (Ottogi International House): Wi-Fi Replacement Work
2. If the dormitory is subjected to any maintenance work, there can be noises and entry of workers accompanied by staff members to the building
3. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type

■ Dormitory Life

1. **Wi-Fi connectivity may be unstable, as multiple users will be sharing the same internet line** (unstable Wi-Fi may cause limitations in attending online classes or taking online exams)
2. Curfew Policy
 - Applicable to: Undergraduate students of E-House and Hanwoori (not applicable to I-House)
 - Curfew hours: 00:00 to 05:00
