

Notice on the Spring 2026 Course Evaluation (Undergraduate Program)

※ Starting from the Spring Semester of 2026, the Korean title of the Course Evaluation at Ewha Womans University has been changed to ‘수강소감’, and the evaluation questions have been fully revised.

The Spring 2026 Course Evaluation will be conducted as follows. Please inform professors and students of the following details.

A. Selecting Customized Course Evaluation Questions (For Faculties)

1. Period: 2026. 6. 8. (Mon.) 13:00 – 6. 10. (Wed.) 23:59

2. Methods: Eureka log-in→ My Eureka→ Academic admin.→ Class Management
→ Select Customized Course Evaluation Questions
(Refer to the attachment 3 & 4 for details).

3. During the given period, professors can add up to 5 questions from the list to the course evaluation. The result of those selected customized questions will not be added to the average. (If there is no addition to the questions, course evaluation will be conducted with the basic list of questions. It would be impossible to add any questions after the given period.)

4. The courses excluded from the course evaluation are as follows:

- ① Applied Music(College of Music), Independent Studies(College of Art & Design), clinical training-related courses(College of Medicine, College of Nursing), pharmaceutical practice-related courses(College of Pharmacy)
- ② Special lecture series
- ③ Field Training(such as Internship or Teaching Practice), Self-directed learning
- ④ Classes taught by more than 4 lecturers
- ⑤ Teaching Aptitude·Personality Tests, Educational Practicum, individual research, First-year Seminar, HOKMA Seminar
- ⑥ College/Advanced English exemption
- ⑦ Credit exchange
- ⑧ Graduate school Common Subject(Individual Research, Seminar in Thesis, etc.)
- ⑨ Self-Planning Modules

5. Professors with low course evaluation results (that is, during the previous 4 semesters, if the average evaluation score is lower than 3.3 for 2 or more semesters including the current one) are required to take course consulting.

B. Course Evaluation (For Students, including exchange students)

1. Period: 2026. 6 12. (Fri.) 13:00 – 6. 23 (Tue.) 12:00

2. Courses: All Courses that have been opened for undergraduate programs in the Spring semester 2026.
※ Excluded courses have been noted as such on the list.
3. Methods: Eureka→ Academics→ Courses→ Course evaluation
4. Even for the courses that are excluded from the regular course evaluation, you can still leave comments to open-ended questions.
5. If you do not complete at least one course evaluation, you will not be able to view your grade until 6. 23. (Tue.) 23:59. Written comments on the excluded courses will not be subject for such restriction.
6. Your responses are anonymous; the written comments are viewed by the alphabetical order of the comments.

C. Monitoring and encouraging students' participation (For Office)

1. Each college office is requested to monitor the live updates of participation rates by college and major during the survey period. You can use online and offline board or send text messages or any other ways to encourage more students to participate.
2. Methods: Eureka→ My Eureka→ Undergraduate/Graduate Program→ Course Evaluation → Participation rate of Course Evaluation for each College
