Notice for the Exchange Program of Fall 2026

[English test score]

When applying for the exchange program, you must submit an official language certificate

(English) acquired one year (after January 1, 2025) before the date of application. However, the

acquisition deadline is only applicable in the selection period at Ewha. In general, documents

acquired two years before the time of application of the exchange university (not in the

application period at Ewha but in the application period of your university of choice) are

recognized at the time of application of the exchange university. Also, the exact conversion

criteria and details related to English test scores vary by exchange universities, so please check

the detailed standards for each university.

You can check the exchange university's Fact Sheet and website, or contact the person in

charge of the international affairs for all matters regarding the English test score standards,

acquisition date, and other requirements for the application.

If exchange universities require scores in all four areas of English (reading, listening, speaking,

and writing), you will have to prepare certificates accordingly to apply without any problems.

If problems arise in the application process of the exchange university you have been

designated for not having checked the standards or requirements accurately, it will be the

student's responsibility.

In addition, it is a requirement to submit all documents, including official English tests scores,

by the document submission deadline. If you do not submit documents within the deadline, you

will be excluded from the document screening.

[Tips for preparing your documents and for the interview]

- ▷ Please carefully check the required documents before the submission to ensure that there are no missing documents. The student will be responsible if there are missing documents.
- -Required documents: please check the notice board in the GSB webpage

▷ Please do not use translators when writing the Statement of Purpose. Please write it yourself as it is for the confirmation of you English proficiency as well.

> The interview will take about 5 to 10 minutes and it will be in English. Please prepare for the interview but do not prepare a script.

[FAQ]

Q. How is the selection process and what is the competition rate?

In the first stage, the student will be assigned a university according to the order of universities the student has applied for. If circumstances allow, the student will be assigned one of the three universities the student has applied for. However, if applications are concentrated in some universities, students who have obtained the highest scorers in the documents screening and the interview will be allocated first. The competition rate cannot be announced as it is different every year.

It is rare that students are not selected for the exchange program unless the student has a very low English test score. If you are not assigned to any of the three universities you have applied for, you will be assigned to another university that can accept more students. The total number of students each university can accept varies every semester, and it cannot be revealed to students. If a student is not assigned any of the three universities and has to be assigned to another university, the office will contact the student individually.

All other important matters related to document submission and interviews and university assignments will be sent via e-mail. Please use an e-mail address that you use often when applying, and check your e-mail as often as possible so that you don't miss any process.

Q. Do you also accept TOEFL iBT Home Edition?

We do accept TOEFL iBT Home Edition in the application at Ewha. However, you will have to check whether the exchange university you are applying for accepts TOEFL iBT Home Edition. Please note that the student will be responsible if any problem arises in the application process for not having checked them thoroughly.

Q. I haven't met the language requirements of the university I want to apply for yet. Can I apply with only my current English score?

If you have a valid English test score, you can apply for the exchange program. However, if the exchange university does not accept a student because she does not meet the language requirements by the time of the application of the exchange university, it will be the student's responsibility. Also, the student won't be able to apply for the exchange program in the future.

Therefore, please carefully check the language requirements for each exchange university. Also, if the exchange universities require scores in all four areas of English (reading, listening, speaking, and writing), you must meet all these requirements.
