Opportunity to engage with fellow students from Mahidol University (Thailand), Ewha Womans University (Korea) and Fukuoka Women's University (Japan)

- Eligibility: Undergraduate/graduate **FEMALE students** are eligible to apply. No Thai, Korean or Japanese language skills are required.
- Credits: Participants may earn credits by home university.
- Tuition Fee: 10,000 THB per person (includes field trips, lectures, and activities. Dorm fee and Airfare is NOT included.)
- Application deadline: **June 1, 2026.**
