

2026 Education Course on Human Rights and Prevention violence

① **Target Audience:** Current students of this university (including both undergraduate and graduate students)

② **Purpose:** To foster human rights awareness and gender sensitivity, and to prevent gender-based violence

③ **Course:** 2026 인권 및 폭력예방교육(학생)

④ **How to Participate**

a. [When accessing via PC] Go to Cyber Campus

(<http://cyber.ewha.ac.kr>)

➔ Click on “2026 인권 및 폭력예방교육(학생)” under “Extracurricular Programs”

➔ Under “Topic-Based Learning Activities,” click on the “Required” 2026 Human Rights and Violence Prevention Education course to take it

(*you can choose between Korean, English, or Chinese)

b. [When accessing via smartphone/tablet] Download the Cyber Campus app, then complete the course using the same method as described above

Note If you access the course through applications such as Chrome or Naver instead of the Cyber Campus app, completion cannot be verified

⑤ How to Verify Completion and Obtain a Certificate of Completion:

- a. On the left side of Cyber Campus, select [Extracurricular Programs] > [Completion Verification] (It takes approximately 30 minutes for the certificate to appear.)
- b. You can issue and print your certificate from the [Extracurricular Programs] >> [Completion Verification] menu on the left side of the Cyber Campus

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
